Dave and Darlene Eby are going to Uganda as Second Career missionaries. He grew up in Pasadena, CA, she in Chicago. They met at a Young Life camp in Colorado and have been married over 36 years. The Ebys have five grown children and five grandchildren. Dave has pastored North City Presbyterian Church in San Diego, a Mission to North America plant he started in 1985, for twenty years.

The Ebys have been to Uganda with several short-term teams and have helped the Presbyterian Church in Uganda to plant two churches near Kampala, the capital city. They will join the MTW team in Kampala, focusing on training pastors and church planters at Westminster Theological College (WTC). Dave plans to work on developing a graduate level seminary—a huge need for Africa's burgeoning

church and to direct the African version of Embers to a Flame, a conference and mentoring ministry aimed at promoting Biblical health and revitalization among Ugandan and Kenyan churches. Darlene will use her gifts at WTC in administration, teaching, and women's ministries.
