Since joining MTW in 1989, she has worked helping children in other lands have the same opportunity to hear the gospel while they, too, are young (2 Timothy 3:15).

After teaching at Alliance Academy in Quito, Ecuador, for several years, Carla was called in 1999 to help the Presbyterian Church in Belize in its endeavor to strengthen their Christian school program. Carla, working alongside Belizean leaders, developed courses to help teachers understand the

implications of a Reformed, biblical worldview on education, and implement strategies to improve their effectiveness in the classroom.

Having successfully completed this work with the Belizean Church, Carla is now creating a similar program to be used by the Presbyterian Church in other countries. Her mission focus is to encourage an interest in and to facilitate the creation of God-centered, covenantal day and home schools in established, Reformed-minded churches abroad. While developing this new program, Carla plans to complete a doctoral program in adult education to better serve the peoples of many nations.
