In July 1998, the Spirit of the Lord placed a heavy burden on the hearts of the Wadhams to move from Cape Town, South Africa, to the U.S. to work with Native Americans. This burden increased with further study and reading literature such as Dee Brown's *Bury My Heart at Wounded Knee* and *The Trail of Tears*, telling the story of the relocation of the Cherokee to Oklahoma.

With Michael's experience in ministry and continuing theological studies, and Lindie's education in social work, they came to the U.S. and settled in North Carolina where they entered a full-time pulpit ministry on the Cherokee Indian

reservation.

God later moved them to Charlotte, N.C., where for eight years they continued in ministry and study. After completing a master of theology in missiology, the burden to return to Native American ministry has led Michael and his family to the Lummi nation in Washington State. Their work there will incorporate relational evangelism, and mentoring/discipleship, with the long-term goal of planting a Native church (Romans 15:20-12).
