

## Athens, Greece

### Ministry Description

Mission teams are needed to support church-planting efforts in Athens Greece. Due to border closings and European Union agreements, over ten thousand refugees are currently stranded in Athens. The Greek Evangelical Church designed the Center of Hope to be a safe haven for women and children. Here they can come for respite, a place for tea, for their kids to play, a place where they can receive basic necessities, and feel human again for awhile.



### Project Description

Teams will serve at the Center of Hope facility, ministering primarily to women and their children. We will serve as support to both the existing staff and the visitors coming to the Center, which can receive several hundred people daily. Tasks may include: serving tea, playing with children, cleaning, organizing, helping by giving staff a break, and putting a hand on a shoulder when words do not work.

### Housing/Food

Teams will be housed in local apartments that the church owns (sheets and towels will be provided). Breakfast will be at the apartments, while lunch and dinner will be out at local cafes or restaurants.

### Project Costs

The estimated cost is approximately \$1240 based on a 12 day trip. Airfare is not included. Teams will use local public transportation and a good amount of walking.
