

Vision Trip to Arequipa, Peru

Ministry Description

Nestled between the coast and the southern highlands, Arequipa is one of the most beautiful and interesting cities in Peru. It's also Peru's second largest, with a population of nearly one million people. Arequipa exists in the shadow of the towering El Misti volcano which rises to over 19,000 feet. El Misti's perfect snow-capped cone is thought to have been worshipped by ancient Incas, yet now lies dormant.



In the midst of this same shadow, two MTW families, The Bonhams (Nathan and Nikki), and the Gutierrez family (Nathaniel and Alicia) are working to bring the light of the gospel to a place mired in a religious syncretistic mix of Roman Catholicism and animism.

MTW is looking for several adventurous individuals interested in making the trek to Arequipa to experience firsthand the work of these two families. You'll get to see the scope of their ministry and hear about their vision of establishing Christ-centered churches and leaders in an area that has been resistant to the gospel.
