

Love Muslims in Europe - 2023

One in three non-Christians in the world is a Muslim, yet only 6% of missionaries are working among Muslims. Take the first step towards making a difference. Join us!

Our overall goal is to grow in love for God, love for the church and love for the lost—particularly Muslims. The focus of the trip is learning and doing cross-cultural evangelism. You will meet and share the gospel with Muslims while serving in the context of an international church(s) in a neighborhood where you will meet people from other backgrounds as well. Expect to grow in grace as we apply it to our own lives and explain it to others.

For people coming on a short trip, an “easy” way to talk with a Muslim is to ask people walking by on the street, “Are you sure of going to Paradise?” Often Muslims stop and talk, for maybe 30-45 minutes. In addition, we will engage the community in ways that the church finds beneficial, as well as introduce you to Muslim friends and Christians from a Muslim background. Through all of this, including meals and cultural experiences, you will be trained and debriefed by seasoned workers. We hope your participation will be the beginning of

learning to love Muslims. No prior knowledge of Islam is required, just a willingness to get out of your comfort zone and be a witness of the gospel of grace.



To help you get the maximum benefit from the trip we ask:

- Be willing to try foods from around the Muslim world.
- Be willing to initiate conversations with Muslims in the community. The training will help you get started and we will be doing it together or in pairs.
- Be willing to focus on the purpose of the trip. You will have

one day off for sightseeing. Other down time is to be spent taking a break or processing.

- For the ease of travel and loving your neighbor, we ask people to be Covid vaccinated.
- Be committed to completing the online training before the trip. We will have four Zoom sessions for about an hour, plus about 30 minutes of prep before each session and 30 minutes of practice in pairs after each session. The dates and times for the Zoom calls will be arranged by consensus, though we have found Sunday afternoons to work well.
- We also ask that participants be open to how the Lord might lead them to reach out to Muslims locally or overseas in the future.
